I am very excited about being at Harold McCormick Elementary School, as well as having your child in my class! We have a busy yet fun and exciting year ahead of us.

- B.E.E. (Bring Everything Everyday) notebook. This will help in carrying homework, money, notes, and other effects to and from school. When placing money in your child's B.E.E. notebook please place it in a bag with your child's name on it as well as the purpose for the money I.E. lunch.
- B.E.E. notebook-Will contain homework assignments and words we are learning that week.
- B.E.E. Notebook- Calendar; I will mark the behavior of your child for that day on the calendar. Please initial the date after seeing the behavior. 😊 Means good behavior. A face with a straight line means some misbehavior. 😐 This face means that there was a consistency of bad behavior; this face will also be accompanied with a note to explain. some
  - I keep track of behavior on a stop light. Everyone starts on green every day. When a child does not follow rules their name will be moved to the yellow light (the straight face). If put on the yellow light the child has time out from centers or when we go outside. If the misbehavior continues then the child's name will be moved to the red light (the sad face). When on the red light, the child must miss centers or the time we have outside. If the behavior continues the next step is being sent to Mr. Culbert. I hope that this step will not be necessary.
- Throughout the year I will be communicating with you through different venues, phone calls, notes home, and parent- teacher conferences. A good parent teacher relationship is important to schools success.

I know that our lives are busy but please read every night to your child.
