

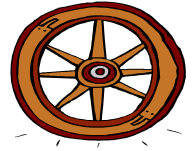
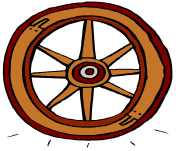
Miss Beth's Buckaroos

- ★ Enjoy this year with your child. They grow up so fast. Try to go on a fieldtrip or visit our classroom to share some special time with your child. They will be in high school before you know it!
