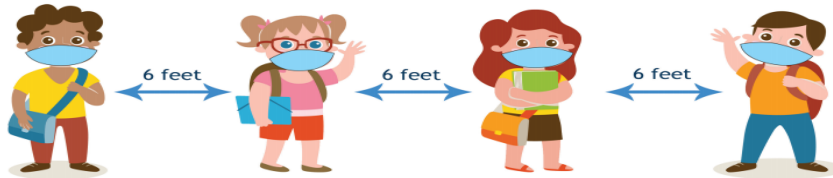

SOME FRIENDLY REMINDERS: PROCEDURES FOR ENTERING THE SCHOOL:



Temperatures will be taken prior to entering the school building. Please remain in your vehicle and wait until student's temperature has been checked and confirmed it is below 100.4. If your child has a temperature of 100.4, they will not be allowed to stay at school.

Masks are expected to be worn by all faculty, staff, and students. PLEASE REMEMBER TO WASH MASKS AT LEAST 2 TIMES A WEEK

Arrival/Dismissal Procedures

Parents will be able to drop students off at HME beginning at 7:30 a.m.

*** Parents and all visitors are expected to have on a mask to enter the building. Temperatures will be taken, if you have a temperature of 100.4 you will not be allowed to remain in the building. The office has been moved to the library during this time of construction.**

Arrival-Due to construction at the main entrance, students will be entering the school from the second entrance in the front parking lot. This will include all 2nd, 3rd grade, and SPED students along with older siblings dropped off also. K, 1st, 4th, and 5th grade will be dropped off in the gym.

Dismissal procedures will remain the same as last year. Kindergarten and 1st grade will be dismissed from the front parking lot and 2nd-5th will be dismissed from the gym.
